



Fairfield Preparatory Dress Code 25-26

Students are required to wear school uniform daily.

- Blue, Orange, Gray, or Black Polo Shirts (long or short sleeve).
- Khaki, Gray, Navy Blue or Black bottoms (pants, shorts, skirts, skirts, skirts, skirts, or jumpers) must have button and or zipper closure for Grade 2 and above. Sweatpants, overalls, leggings, floor length dresses, or jeggings are not acceptable bottoms.
- Black or Brown Belts must be worn with bottoms with belt loops.
- All shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers must be knee length and can be worn in the months of April through September only.
- Solid Color Crewneck Sweatshirts and Cardigan or Pull over Sweaters may be worn over Uniform Shirts. They must be free of designs or logos larger than 1 inch and may not have a hood.
- Students may also wear school logo tops with athletic bottoms any day of the school week. Athletic bottoms can be sweatpants or other styles (no leggings or yoga style pants) that are worn for the purpose of athletic activity.
- Dress shoes or tennis shoes may be worn. No moccasins, sandals, or boots. Shoes Must be close toed and not have high heels.
- Hats or head coverings cannot be worn in the building (except for religious purposes).

Physical Education Class Dress Code

All grades:

- ***Tennis shoes must be worn on scheduled physical education days, which is every day.*** Students may bring a pair of shoes to change into or leave at school.
- For certain athletic events students will be allowed to wear a different athletic uniform.
- Parents will be notified about these special events.
